How to prepare for the assessment and what to expect:

- Once your application is received, an assessment specialist will contact you to schedule an assessment appointment. Please mark your calendar for the assessment appointment (if you do not meet your auditor or are more than 25 minutes late you will forfeit your spot in the program).
- Please lock up all pets prior to the assessment appointment.
- The assessment will take approximately 30 minutes, plus 20 minutes to review and explain the resiliency measures identified for your home, including an overview of the rebate and implementation process.

Documents to have ready for the assessment (if possible!):

- Elevation certificate
- Pictures of prior damage
- Most recent utility bills; electric, natural gas, water and sewer
